Railway Scene – Europe's largest railway museum

Chemnitz and the railway simply belong together. Saxony's first locomotives were being built here from 1848 – even before the Saxon industrial metropolis was connected to the railway network in 1852.

The museum harbours more than 30 historic locomotives as well as unique technical equipment. With 260,000 square metres of floor space, the museum gives visitors the chance to experience railways up-close.
